

Lena Bosch Lifetime Achievement Award Standards

Purpose of Award

The Lena Bosch Lifetime Achievement Award, established in 2020, recognizes individuals who have exhibited outstanding, creative, innovative and visionary leadership in the growth and advancement of the arts in our community through involvement in the Annette Howell Turner Center for the Arts (Center).

Awards Task Force

- 1. Nominations will be judged by an awards task force, appointed biannually by the LVAC Executive Committee, based solely on the content provided on the award application. The task force's selection is subject to approval by the LVAC Board of Directors.
- 2. All nominations will be assessed on their comparative merits by the awards task force, who will decide the eventual recipient by majority vote. The award should not be viewed to be in any way competitive, and is not intended to be an annual award.
- 3. All submissions for this recognition are considered in confidence by the awards task force, and nominations will not be publicly disclosed. Members of the task force, the LVAC Board of Directors and the Turner Center staff are not eligible for this award while they hold office or are employed by the Center.

Nomination Criteria and Procedures

The Nomination Criteria and Procedures are outlined in the Award Guidelines Document.

Additional Mandates

- 1. After selection of the first recipient, a list of Past Recipients shall be included in all future Nomination Packets.
- 2. Names of recipients will be displayed on a plaque to be exhibited in a prominent location of the Center's main facility.
- 3. Each recipient will receive a commemorative award of a value to be determined by the Center's Executive Director in keeping with Center budget allowances.
